



**Swagger Factory Apparel STSS Crate 602 Sportsman –
40 laps, \$2,500 to win, \$125 to start**

*Round No. 5: Bob Hilbert Sportswear Fueled By Sunoco Crate 602 Sportsman Madsen
Overhead Doors North Region*

Engine:

Open to GM Crate 602 engines ONLY. 6,200 rev chip required.

Weight:

All cars must weigh a minimum of 2,350 lbs.

**Track-scale pounds, taken post-race with driver in car*

Tires:

Right-Rear: American Racer 56 ONLY (any track/series stamp)

Left-Rear: American Racer 48 ONLY (any track/series stamp)

Right-Front: American Racer 48 ONLY (any track/series stamp)

Left-Front: Any American Racer tire (any track/series stamp)

**Standard dirt Modified tires ONLY permitted.*

**Tires are subject to durometer readings after each event. Outliers will be sent out for laboratory testing.*

Body Rules:

Standard bodies only; no sail panels or other deviations.

Qualifying:

Drivers will draw for assignments of Qualifying Race groups. Qualifying Race groups will hot lap together. Hot laps will be timed. Qualifying Race starting positions will be determined by hot lap times with an invert of the redraw positions: if the redraw is four (4), the fastest driver in each hot lap group will start fourth, with the fourth-fastest starting on the pole. Remaining starting positions will be “head’s-up” based on time.

Qualifying Races will be 12 laps in distance. B-Mains (8 laps) will set the remainder of the field on Saturday, Sept. 14 prior to the 40-lap, \$2,500-to-win main event.

The feature starting lineup will be determined as follows prior to provisional starters.

A *minimum* of 26 cars will start the main event.

There will be a total of three (3) provisionals available for this event. The two-highest-ranked drivers in current 2024 STSS Crate 602 Sportsman Madsen Overhead Doors North Region standings unable to qualify (*half green money*) in addition to the highest-ranked driver in 2024 final Fonda Speedway Swagger Factory Apparel Crate 602 Sportsman point standings (*half green money*) will be eligible for provisionals.

Fonda Speedway/Utica-Rome rules apply for this event.

Draw for heat-race starting positions. Redraw of top qualifiers for the 20-lap main event. A field of 26 cars will start the feature. Heats and consolations are 8 laps.

Fuel: Sunoco is the preferred fuel of the speedway. Can-Am Crate, Sunoco Race Fuels 110 or equivalent. No oxygenated fuels.

Tires: Fonda Speedway American Racer 50 compound or Hoosiers are permitted for this event.

There is no car registration fee for this event.

AMB transponders are required at this event.

One-way radios are mandatory. The frequency is 454.000.

Fonda Speedway Limited Sportsman rules and eligibility requirements apply for this event – 2024 track champion *is permitted* at this event.

Engine:

Open to GM Crate 602 engines ONLY. 6,200 rev chip required.

Weight:

All cars must weigh a minimum of 2,350 lbs.

**Track-scale pounds, taken post-race with driver in car*

Tires:

Right-Rear: American Racer 56 compound or Hoosier D300 or harder (*any track/series stamp*)

Left-Rear: American Racer 48 compound or Hoosier D300 or harder (*any track/series stamp*)

Right-Front: American Racer 48 compound or Hoosier D300 or harder (*any track/series stamp*)

Left-Front: Any American Racer tire or Hoosier D300 or harder (*any track/series stamp*)

**Standard chain-link Modified tires only; no block-tread tires.*

Fuel: Sunoco is the preferred fuel of the speedway. Can-Am Crate, Sunoco Race Fuels 110 or equivalent. No oxygenated fuels.

Draw for heat-race starting positions. Redraw of top qualifiers for the 20-lap main event. Heats and consolations are 6 laps.

AMB transponders are required at this event.

One-way radios are mandatory. The frequency is 454.000.

Payout: 1) \$500; 2) \$200; 3) \$100; 4) \$50; 5) \$35; 6-Last) \$25

Fonda Fair Four Cylinders – 15 laps, \$150 to win (both Single and Dual Cam)

Fonda Speedway weekly rules apply for this event.

Draw for position determines the lineup for the 15-lap feature.

There is no car registration fee for this event.

Payout: 1) \$150 (Single & Dual Cam); 2) \$75; 3) \$50; 4) \$35; 5-26) \$25.
