Big- and Small-Block Engines: 2,400 lbs.

CT 525: 2,300 lbs.

PA/NJ/DIRTcar Spec Small-Block – open carburetor, no rev limiter (gasoline): 2,275 lbs.

W-16: 2,250 lbs.

All weights are track scale pounds, with driver, post-race

No Big-Block engine may exceed 477 cubic inches; No Small-Block engine may exceed 450 cubic inches

Body Rules:

Sail panels must be even and mirror each other in size and shape, side-for-side. Maximum height when measured from the ground is 65 inches. Sail panels must extend no further forward than the rear of the driver's seat and no further back than the end of the quarter-panel. *There will be no alterations (louvers, cut-outs, etc.) permitted to the sail panels.* A roof spoiler/wickerbill, no taller than four inches, is permitted.

All other Fonda Speedway/Short Track Super Series body rules apply for this event.

Tires:

Fronts: America Racer 33 or harder

Left-Rear: American Racer 44 or 48 ONLY

Right-Rear: American Racer 48 or 50 ONLY

Qualifying:

Drivers will draw for their heat-race starting positions at the pre-race drivers' meeting. Heat races will be 8 laps in distance. Top qualifiers from each heat race will redraw. Consolations (8 laps) will set the remainder of the 24-car starting field.

Race Procedures:

All heat-race restarts are double file. Feature restarts are double file until the final five laps. In the event of two cautions on the same lap, the ensuing restart is single file until a lap is scored. Lapped cars drop to the rear in the order they are running. The first car one lap down at the time of a yellow in the feature event only will get the 'Lap Down, Go-Around' and will be tagged at the tail end of the lead lap. Heat races and consolations are 8 laps in distance. The feature event is 40 laps.

The one-way radio frequency is 454.000. AMB Transponders will be utilized.
