Amsterdam Truck Center Modifieds with sail panels – 40 laps, \$12,000 to win, \$1,000 for 10th, \$400 to start

Engines & Weights:

Big- and small-block engine combinations are permitted at Fonda Speedway. Steel-block only (exceptions can be made for approved W-16, LS and spec combinations). No small-block engine may exceed 450 cubic inches. No big-block engine may exceed 477 cubic inches. Must be (single) carbureted; no fuel injection.

Big- and Small-Block engines: 2,400 lbs.

Wegner LS 427 Weekend Warrior Spec (steel-block): 2,350 lbs.

CT 525: 2,300 lbs.

PA/NJ/DIRTcar Spec Small-Block – open carburetor, no rev limiter (gasoline): 2,275 lbs.

W-16: 2,250 lbs.

**All weights are tracks scale pounds, post-race, with driver.*

Tires:

Right-Rear: American Racer SD 50 or 56 compound only

Left-Rear: American Racer SD 48 compound only

Right-Front: American Racer SD 48 compound only

Left-Front: Any American Racer tire

**No softening or chemically altering of tires. Durometer readings will be taken after all events.*

Outliers are subject to laboratory testing.

Body Rules:

Sail panels are permitted for this event. Sail panels must be even and mirror each other in size and shape, side-for-side. Maximum height when measured from the ground is 65 inches. Sail panels must extend no further forward than the rear of the driver's seat and no further back than the end of the quarter-panel. *There will be no alterations (louvers, cut-outs, etc.) permitted to the sail panels.* A roof spoiler/wickerbill, no taller than four inches, is permitted.

Door heights are as follows: maximum height of 41 inches on the left side and 40 inches on the right when measured 60 inches forward from the centerline of the rear axle.

Left-Side Measurement Points:

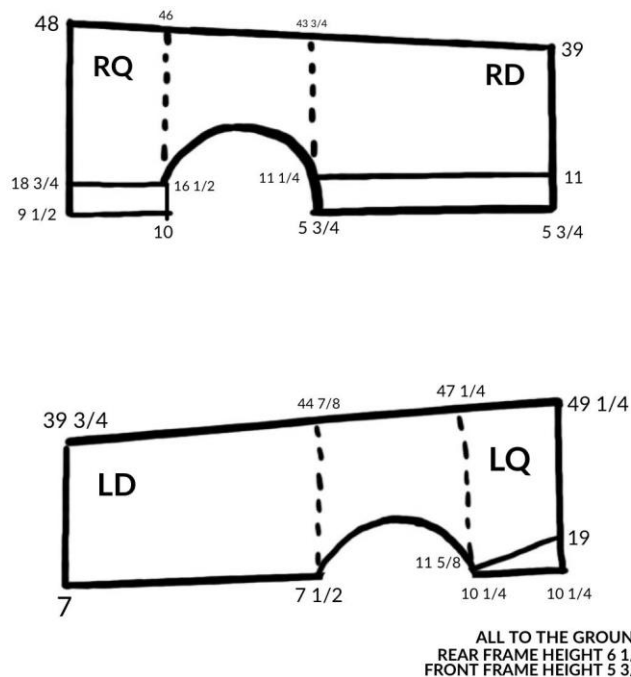
16 inches forward from centerline of rear axle: 45 inches maximum, 37 inches minimum
60 inches forward from centerline of rear axle: 41 inches maximum, 36 inches minimum

Right-Side Measurement Points:

16 inches forward from centerline of rear axle: 44 inches maximum, 36 inches minimum
60 inches forward from centerline of rear axle: 40 inches maximum, 35 inches minimum

There cannot be more than a one-inch difference from left door to right door in split when measured from the ground.

Please reference the diagram below for door dimensions:



The maximum combined length of door and quarter together, front to back, is as follows:

- *Left Side:* 11 feet, 4.5 inches on the top of the combined door/quarter; 11 feet, 5 inches on the bottom of the combined door/quarter
- *Right Side:* 11 feet, 3 inches on both the top and bottom of the combined door/quarter

Rear spoiler rule maximum height: 50 inches – must be even from left to right. Minimum ground clearance of 6 inches in door skirting and 8-inch minimum for rear quarter-panel skirting.

Maximum body width, when measured at any point along the body line from front-to-back will be a maximum of 68 inches and minimum of 64 inches.

Aluminum surrounding fuel cell is optional.

All other measurements are to mirror the standard for Northeast dirt Modified racing. Fonda Speedway officials have final decision on all discrepancies.

Pay Structure:

Lineups:

Heat-race lineups will be determined via a draw for position at the pre-race drivers' meeting. Top qualifiers will transfer to the redraw; other remaining qualifiers go to the main event. Consolations, with top finishers transferring, will set the remainder of the 24-car starting field. Heats and consolations are 10 laps in distance. The highest driver from 2022 final Fonda Speedway points unable to qualify will be added as a provisional starter (half green money).

Starts & Restarts:

All heat-race and consolation restarts will be double-file. Feature event restarts are double-file through lap 34. The final five laps will be single-file. Lapped cars drop to the rear in the order they are running. Initial starts are at the Sunoco Start Point in turn four. Restarts take place within the restart zone.

One-Way Radio:

The one-way radio frequency is 454.000.

Transponders:

AMB transponders are mandatory. Rentals are available at the track.

Points:

This event will reward 25 show-up points to all drivers attempting to qualify for the Modified event.
